- Make sure you have an active library account! If you're unsure, contact us at 781-741-1405 x1402 or hilib@ocln.org. A physical card is always best, but you can also sign up for an eCard (this card can access almost everything except Hoopla): <http://www.hinghamlibrary.org/148/Library-Cards>.
- Looking for a particular book? Browse through our online catalog (<https://catalog.ocln.org>) and either put books on hold OR contact us at 781-741-1405 x1404, or hiref@ocln.org, to have us help you out!
- If you're looking for eBooks or eAudio, try Overdrive/Libby. Hoopla *also* has eBooks, and they stream movies and music! Check them both out at: <http://www.hinghamlibrary.org/236/eBooks-Downloads>.
- We have a wide variety of databases covering every topic you'll need for school and personal projects. Some of them are similar to what's available through the High School library, but many are unique. Check them out 24/7 at: <http://www.hinghamlibrary.org/194/General-Research>.
