Looking ahead...

- Our orchestra groups will perform on Tuesday 12/12 at 7 PM in the HHS auditorium.
- Wednesday 12/13 marks the midpoint of the term, so students and parents can count on updates to grades in the Aspen portal.
- The <u>Hingham Unity Council</u>, a valued community partner, will host a program about "<u>Social Media and Rising Extremism</u>" at the Town Hall on Tuesday 12/12 at 7 PM.

As announced last week, HHS has eliminated the rear door between the gym and auto shop as an entrance for students before school. To enhance security, this door will remain locked in the morning and throughout the school day. Before 8 AM, all students should enter the building at the main Union Street entrance or the side Pleasant Street door. After 8 AM, any late arrivals should enter at the main door.

Our hardworking maintenance crew was on the job early Wednesday, so the parking lot was clear, just in time for school!




