Looking ahead:

- A food drive to benefit the Hingham Food Pantry will be held during the girls' basketball game (vs. Duxbury) tonight. As was the case during the boys' game on Tuesday night, anyone who donates at least one non-perishable food item will be admitted to the game for free.
- A movie night (free for HHS students) will be held after the basketball game tonight.
- Seniors should take the time to explore the <u>many Town of Hingham scholarship opportunities</u>. Applications must be submitted by 3 PM on Friday 3/8.
- Registration remains open for the SAT, which will be offered at HHS during the school day for the first time on Friday 4/12 from 8 - 11 AM. The "SAT School Day" is for juniors only, completely optional, and requires an <u>online signup</u>. Juniors who do not take the SAT that day will attend their regular classes; meanwhile, class absences for those who take the SAT will be considered exempt.

An important announcement about the 2024 Andrew B. Warhaftig Memorial Scholarship for HHS seniors in band, chorus or orchestra: Andrew was a member of the HHS Class of 2019 who lost his battle with FSGS kidney disease in the spring of his junior year. We held NephCure day yesterday during Unity Week in his memory. **Four \$2500 scholarships** will be awarded in Andrew's name this spring to seniors who are in a music ensemble at HHS (band, orchestra or chorus). You do not need to be planning to major in music in college to apply and the deadline is March 1, 2024. Andrew loved music and it is an honor to keep his legacy alive through this scholarship. 
Maddie's Promise


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
