Course Description:

Welcome to World Geography! We will start off the year with a unit on geography skills and tools (Latitude and Longitude, reading maps, etc.). Then we will focus on different regions of the world while applying our new skills. Throughout the year, we will follow the five major themes of geography: place, location, movement, regions, and human-environment interaction.
