- School Updates
 - Teachers supporting the No Homework Night on 11/1 for Town Meeting
 - One Book, One School (OBOS) on 11/2. Author of book will be presenting to each class. Supplemental classroom activities provided as well.
 - Veteran's Day Breakfast to honor current and former military veterans.
 - Second Step will be starting term 2. 9 lessons for each class (3 per term).
