






The Course Selection Process Step 2 – After logging in, click on the "My Info" tab




Step 3 – Click on the "Requests" side tab




The Course Selection Process Step 4 – View Course Selections



The Course Selection Process Step 5 – View Recommended Courses




Primary Elective Requests




Students should select **three** electives.


