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### **Parent/Guardian Survey--Learning Model Transition/In Person Learning**

*February 22, 2021*

#### Elementary In-Person Learning:

On February 8, 2021, HPS announced a proposed plan for the return of Grades 1-5 to full in-person learning. As the district plans for this potential transition, the resulting in-person learning model would mean that the current three cohort hybrid model would no longer be in effect at the elementary level. A shift to full in-person learning will require elementary teachers to focus their undivided attention on student safety and in-person instruction. As a result, those families who choose to remain in the remote learning model may see their elementary student's schedule supplemented by direct instruction and academic support provided by different instructional staff. In order to plan for the Grade 1-5 transition to full in-person learning, the district is asking elementary families to commit to either in-person or remote learning for the remainder of the 2020-2021 school year. #### Middle & High School In-Person Learning:

As the district continues to plan for increased in-person learning at the secondary level, the number of families who would be opting for in-person versus remote learning at 3 foot distancing (rather than the current 6 foot distancing) is key to our planning. While there is no request for secondary families to "commit" to in-person or remote learning at this time, having a general sense of what families may choose is essential to our planning.
