INCREASED IN-PERSON LEARNING AT HHS

HERE'S WHAT WE KNOW...

- The superintendent's recent proposal recommends that on April 5th...
 - Students can return to school for in-person learning five days per week
 - Cohorts will be eliminated
 - Social distancing requirements will shift from 6' to 3'
 - Remote classes (PE & Music) held during A, C, D and F Blocks will be held in person
 - With the elimination of "Remote Wednesdays," HHS will shift to a two-day rotation for the next two weeks, as follows:
 - Day 1 = A, B, C, H (April 5, 7, 9, 13 & 15)
 - Day 2 = D, E, F, G (April 6, 8, 12, 14 & 16)
 - "Partial-day" schedules (i.e., dismissal at 12:05 PM for most students) will continue through April vacation; G & H Block classes will remain remote
- The superintendent's recent proposal recommends that on April 26th...
 - HHS will shift to a full-day schedule (8:00 AM - 2:32 PM)
 - Details of the schedule (e.g., length and order of the periods, etc.) are still being finalized
- Survey results (i.e., the number of students returning to in-person learning) will impact some details of the schedule (e.g., room locations, number of lunch waves, etc.)
- Safety protocols (e.g., mask requirements, one-way traffic flow in corridors, etc.) will remain in effect
- It is possible that students will occasionally have to participate remotely in class even when they're in the building; this is because some classes may be too large to fit in a regular classroom with 3' social distancing
- Seating at lunch will require 6' spacing with students facing in the same direction
- We expect to have one or two large tents in place by April 26th to help with lunch
