

## Profile of the Graduating Class of 2020 Table of Contents

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## Summary Statements

Page 4 A Summary of Plans
$89.9 \%$ of students in the Class of 2020 attended four-year colleges. The overall percentage of graduates who plan to continue their formal education now stands at 94.8\%.

Pages 17-18 SAT
The SAT changed for students beginning with the class of 2017. There are now two sections: Evidence-Based Reading \& Writing and Math. There is no longer a separate writing section. The total score is out of 1600 possible points each section ranging from 200-800 points. There is an optional essay section of the exam. The College Board reports that scores on the new exam may not be compared to the old exam because the two tests are based on different score scales and different benchmarks. The mean scores on the new SAT for the class of 2020 was 1207 for Hingham High students, 1119 for Massachusetts, and 1051 for the nation.

## SAT Evidence-Based Reading and Writing

Hingham High School's mean score was 608 compared to the Massachusetts mean of 560 and the national mean of 528 .

## SAT Math

Hingham High School's mean score was 599 compared to the Massachusetts mean of 559 and the national mean of 523 .

## Page $19 \quad$ SAT Subject Tests

The SAT Subject Tests are one-hour multiple-choice tests in specific subjects. Unlike the SAT Reasoning Test which measures more general abilities, the SAT Subject Tests measure knowledge of a particular subject and the ability to apply that knowledge. At present, only 3 colleges require SAT Subject Tests and another 13 recommend them for all applicants. There are 13 additional colleges that require or recommend them for certain programs or scholarship eligibility. Over and above these requirements or recommendations, Subject Test scores can serve to highlight a student's areas of strength. The College Board is now reporting Subject Test scores by test year as opposed to graduating year cohort. Unfortunately due to the COVID-19 pandemic, many students were not able to test during the 20192020 school year because Subject Tests are primarily taken in the spring and those tests were cancelled. None of the Subject Tests, with the exception of Math Level Il had enough students to report a mean score.

## Page 19 Biology SAT Subject Tests

In Hingham, the Biology test (Ecological or Molecular) is usually taken by honorslevel students upon completion of the course in the $9^{\text {th }}$ grade year. The Hingham curriculum is aligned to the MCAS rather than the SAT Subject Test. However, between the two subject tests, the curriculum lends itself more to the Ecological focus. Students must complete a good amount of self-directed preparation in order to be prepared for the Biology Subject Tests. Students are generally not exposed to molecular concepts until they have completed chemistry.

## Page 19 Chemistry SAT Subject Test

The Subject Test in Chemistry is usually taken at the end of the $10^{\text {th }}$ grade year in Hingham as compared to at the end of the junior year in the rest of the state and country. There are areas of overlap with the Hingham curriculum and the SAT Subject test material. However, students need to do self-directed outside study in order to be most successful on the exam.

## Page 19 Mathematics Level II SAT Subject Test

The mean score of 695 on the Math Level II is a result of 15 students sitting for the exam. The Math level II exam covers the same material as Math I with the addition of some trigonometry and elementary functions (precalculus) as well.

## Page $20 \quad$ ACT

The ACT Corporation continues to report mean scores and data based on the graduating class cohort. Data contained in this report is for the Class of 2020. 73 students took the ACT. This year's scores decreased slightly compared to those of the previous year. The mean composite score of Hingham students was a 26.6 composite compared to 26 and 20.6 in the state and nation respectively.

Page 21-23 Advanced Placement Exams
Of the 308 graduates of Hingham High School in 2020, 124 seniors took 277 Advanced Placement exams. Approximately $40 \%$ of the graduating class participated in the AP program by taking one or more exams. In total, 247 students took 447 exams. The impressive level of competence demonstrated by our students proves that they are truly ready for college level work. In 2020 the COVID crisis impacted AP testing. Typically, exams are given on paper at the high school. Last year, exams became optional and students who opted to test were sent online exam access codes. Students who did not take advantage of the online access code for the initial exam were automatically sent another access code for a late exam.

Page 24 AP Mean Grades
$40 \%$ of the graduates took an AP class. Our students demonstrated mastery of college level content during high school.

Page 25-28 AP Course Enrollment and Percent of Grade 3 or Better
21 different AP exams were taken in May 2020. 20 were offered at HHS and 1 through our Virtual High School program. $40 \%$ of the senior class participated in the AP program by taking at least one AP class. Hingham has the 16th best AP performance in the state of Massachusetts with a $90 \%$ pass rate on 447 exams.

AP Scholars
100 of the 255 candidates (39\%) who took AP exams were named AP Scholars. 5 of our students were named National Scholars. This award is granted to students who receive an average grade of 4 or higher on all AP exams taken and a grade of 4 or higher on eight or more exams.

Page $30 \quad$ National Merit Scholarships
16 students or $5 \%$ of the graduating class earned recognition from the National Merit Scholarship Corporations as commended students.

## SAT Subject Tests

The SAT Subject Tests are one-hour multiple-choice tests in specific subjects. Unlike the SAT which measures more general abilities, the SAT Subject Tests measure knowledge of a particular subject and the ability to apply that knowledge.

The College Board has changed the way they report Subject Test Scores. They no longer report by graduating class cohort, but rather by testing year. The data in this report reflects Subject Tests taken between August 2018 and July 2019 as well as August 2019 and July 2020. Since the COVID crisis hit and schools and test centers closed beginning in March, 2020, the data for the 19-20 school year is not as robust. Tests centers were largely closed between March and August 2020. The College Board offers about 20 Subject Tests. At present, only 3 colleges require SAT Subject Tests and another 13 recommend them for all applicants. There are 13 additional colleges that require or recommend them for certain programs or scholarship eligibility. Over and above these requirements or recommendations, Subject Test scores can serve to highlight a student's areas of strength. The Biology SAT Subject test in Hingham is taken in June of the $9^{\text {th }}$ grade. Statewide and nationally the test is typically taken in June of the junior year. The Chemistry Subject test in Hingham is taken in June of the 10th grade. Statewide and nationally the test is typically taken in $11^{\text {th }}$ grade.

## Advanced Placement Exams

The Advanced Placement (AP) program consists of a series of college - level courses and exams for secondary school students. Typically over 1 million high school students take at least one AP exam nationwide.
Satisfactory completion of an Advanced Placement examination may make it possible for a student to earn college credit or advanced standing in college prior to arrival on the college campus.

In 2020 the COVID crisis impacted not only the school year and provision of curriculum, but AP testing as well. Typically, exams are given on paper at the high school. Last year, exams became optional and students who opted to test were sent online exam access codes. Students who did not take advantage of the online access code for the initial exam were automatically sent another access code for a late exam.

In 2020, 447 different exams were taken by 247 Hingham High School students. 18 AP classes were offered at HHS and 2 through Virtual High School. Physics students take 2 exams as part of their physics class. Of the 308 graduates of Hingham High School in June 2020, 124 seniors took 277 Advanced Placement exams.
Approximately $40 \%$ of the graduating class participated in the AP program by taking one or more exams. In total, 247 students took 447 exams. Originally 267 students were scheduled to take 483 exams. However, once exams became optional, 247 students took 447 exams. 20 students opted not to take 36 exams.

## Advanced Placement Scholars

AP Scholars are designated in recognition of their exceptional achievement on the college level Advanced Placement (AP) examination. In Hingham, 98 or $39 \%$ of the 247 candidates were so honored. A note regarding 2020 AP Scholar Awards from the College Board "In order to help reduce the burden on students, the AP Program is discontinuing awards that may encourage some students to take large numbers of exams. Starting with the May 2020 AP Exam administration, we'll no longer distribute State AP Scholar, DoDEA AP Scholar, and International AP Scholar awards. Check AP Central for more detailed information. "The AP Scholar award is granted to students who receive grades of 3 or higher on three or more AP exams.

The AP Scholar with Honor award is granted to students who receive an average grade of at least 3.25 on all AP exams taken, and grades of 3 or higher on four or more of these exams.

The AP Scholar with Distinction award is granted to students who receive an average grade of at least 3.5 on all AP exams taken and grades of 3 or higher on five or more of these exams.

The AP National Scholar is granted to students in the US who receive an average grade of at least 4 on all AP exams taken and grades of 4 or higher on eight or more of these exams.

The AP International Diploma is a globally recognized award for students interested in pursuing university study outside of their native country.

The AP Seminar and Research Certificate is awarded to students who earn scores of 3 or higher in AP Seminar and AP Research but not on four additional AP Exams receive the AP Seminar and Research Certificate.

## Hingham High School National Merit Scholarship Competition

Merit scholars are identified from their performance on the PSAT/NMSQT. A student who is identified as a "semifinalist" is one who has scored in the top half of one percent of each state's high school senior class. Scholarship awards made to semifinalists identify those students as finalists. Semifinalists bring honor to their schools and their parents. However, it is the individual student who is recognized in the merit program for outstanding test performance that indicates exceptional academic promise.

Commended students are those who scored among the top two percent of merit program participants who took the qualifying test. Commended students have also demonstrated exceptional academic promise.
